HISTORICAL NOTE: In 1928, Mercy Emergency Hospital was renamed Comstock Hospital after Oliver E. Comstock, a local Baptist preacher who worked to turn Tucson's "Tent City" into a brick-and-mortar hospital to treat tuberculosis patients. It then became Comstock Children's Hospital in 1936 when services shifted to serve children, particularly those in need of prolonged care. The Comstock Children's Hospital closed in 1965 and its assets were transferred to the Comstock Children's Foundation, who continued to provide medical and orthodontics services to children until it became inactive around 2016.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: Miscellaneous documentation from the Comstock Children's Hospital, the Comstock Children's Foundation and their supporting organizations. The documents are not in any discernible order and were put into folders from their corresponding organizations. Also present are several issues of the "Comstock Children's News," a newsletter written by patients, and a script of a radio program in 1948. Box 2 contains a ledger listing children who were admitted to the hospital from the 1930s to 1960s, as well as their ailments and treatment; along with 3 large photographs depicting children at the hospital. One oversized ledger contains newspaper clippings about the hospital.
