**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:** Paul E. Miller (1917-1992) operated the Tucson Photo Company from 1954-1984. In 1970 Miller was presented with the Graphic Arts Alumni Award for his public spirit and his services to the students of Tucson High School.

**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:** This collection contains photographs and drawings printed by the Tucson Photo Company. Photographs include images of bullfighting, the Cinco de Mayo celebration in Nogales, Mexico in 1962 as well as 5 fire damaged views of Pancho Villa. The collection also includes reproductions of sketches and illustrations which depict the southwest by Jo Mora, H. Charles Mcbarron Jr., and other unnamed artists.
