SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: This collection contains documents pertaining to the Commonwealth Mine, also called the Commonwealth Development Company and the Commonwealth Mining and Milling Company, which was located about one mile east of Pearce, Arizona. Documents are primarily focused on the purchase of equipment and services and the payment of employees. It also includes historical information regarding mining in Bisbee, Tonopah and Cripple Creek, a Code of Safe Practice for concentrator ball milling, and Edward Rabb's engineering workbook. The photographs and postcards depict Commonwealth Mine and the surrounding area, including Pearce, Arizona.
