HISTORICAL NOTE

The 50 States Quarters Program was initiated with Public Law No. 105-124 Sec. 3 (b)(A) in 1999 to commemorate each of the 50 states in the order in which the states ratified the United States Constitution and joined the Union. The program was planned to extend for a 10-year period and conclude in 2009 with the last quarter for Hawaii being issued. Each state was encouraged to submit designs representative for their state, its history, and geography. Arizona Governor Janet Napolitano established an Arizona Commission of 22 members in 2005 to coordinate Arizona's program. Anne Woosley from the Arizona Historical Society was selected as a member of this Commission.
