Handwritten, 2-page letter written from Tucson, A.T. from Latham to his sister and describing Tucson, placer digging, the journey back to Fort Craig, visits with Army officers, and the San Xavier Mission.

The letter is only signed "Latham" but it may have been written by John E. Latham, a stagecoach driver on the Butterfield and other routes. John Latham died in Cochise County in 1926 at the age of 83.
