DESCRIPTION

One ledger of handwritten minutes of the stockholders meetings of the Leadville Townsite Leasing & Mining Company in Courtland, Arizona. Also includes one folder of miscellaneous receipts and correspondence. The stockholders named in the ledger are E. A. Rose, R. L. Gibson, William Kline, C. C. Ritter, C. B. Lauders, James Jaffe, Bruce Stephenson and R. L. French. The discussion in the minutes relates to development of the mine.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Courtland's mining boom began in 1909 with the arrival of four large mining companies of which the Leadville was one. Courtland lived for thirty years but none of the mining claims really paid out. By 1934 the town was completely abandoned.
