DESCRIPTION

Contains the autobiography of Peter A. Lofgreen who emigrated to Utah Territory in 1864. A ledger book includes records relating to St. David, Arizona. Papers and correspondence concern the Lofgreen family and the L.D.S. church in Arizona. One folder contains "patriarchal blessing of Peter A. Lofgreen, given under the hands of Patriarch P. C. Merrill, July 15, 1886."

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Pioneer teacher and farmer in St. David, Arizona, was born in Sweden in 1847 and came to the United States in 1864. He first settled in Utah and then moved to St. David in 1884. His reminiscences describe teaching school in St. David where he lived the rest of his life. He died in 1927.
