# **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Barnett M. Mariner was born in Maine in 1849. He moved to Tucson in 1895 and worked for the Southern Pacific railroad. He organized the Mariner's Juvenile Band in 1897, and taught and led the band in his spare time. Mr. Mariner died in Tucson on January 23, 1930 and was interred in Maine.
