BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Little is known of the life of Edith Peach Slaughter Martin. The biographical sketch of the Peach family indicates that they were early pioneers of Arizona, settling around Payson and then on to Strawberry. It appears that Edith graduated from the Normal School in Flagstaff in 1905 and taught at the Strawberry School in 1906-07. When she donated the materials, she was living in Springerville.
