## **DESCRIPTION**

Sketches of profiles of individuals participating in the H.J. Bemmer vs. O.A. Pease trial in Yuma, 1906. The artist was apparently B.L. Meeden, a member of the jury. Included in the sketches was Harry H. McPhaul, identified as a Jury Chambermaid.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Harry McPhaul served in various law enforcement positions in Yuma, Ariz. He was an Arizona Ranger from 1905 to 1906.
