BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Grover C. Miller moved from Lost City, West Virginia to Phoenix, Arizona in 1908. He began working at the Coca Cola Bottling Works in 1909. He also worked as a real state salesman and was a deacon in the First Baptist Church. He was married to Mattie E. Miller.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection contains the personal papers (1910-1923) of Grover C. Miller. The bulk of the papers consist of diaries kept by Mr. Miller dating from 1910 to 1919 as well as Mr. Miller's financial records including bank statements from 1914-1923. It also contains a small amount of printed material including an undated listing of the membership of the First Baptist Church, Phoenix as well as 1913 Arizona hunting license.

On January 8, 1981, Jewel Griffin donated the personal papers of Grover Miller which included primarily diaries and financial records to the Arizona Historical Society, Central Arizona Division.
