DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists of one notary record book, a contract and receipts. The notary book, dated July 1927 to July 1928, includes transactions with names of both parties, and the purpose of the document, i.e. mining deed. Most transactions involve real estate or mining deeds. Individuals include John H. Campbell, Mose Drachman, T. Ed Litt, Ralph Ellinwood, Paul Cella, Jr., J. Knox Corbett, and Emanuel Drachman. One item for Emanuel Drachman, as president of the Old Pueblo Baseball Club, is an affidavit for salary termination for George La Rue, John C. Meaner, and Jack Duffy.

Attorney, Frederick G. Nave was born and raised in Tucson, and graduated from the University of Arizona. He married Valerie Menhennet in 1927. He was a private lawyer before becoming assistant U.S. District Attorney at Tucson in 1929 for a year, after which he returned to private law. In 1942 he was elected president of Pima County Bar Association.
