DESCRIPTION

This collection consists of company papers associated with the New State Mining & Reduction Company between 1907 and 1914. Deeds for mines owned by the company, articles of incorporation as assessments are present. Board of director meeting records and stockholder meeting records are present from 1912 to 1914. In addition there are business contract, legal complaints associated with unpaid bills for mining supplies, and a small amount of correspondence. A 1912 listing of the stockholders of the company is present along with the number of shares owned.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The New State Mining & Reduction Company owned over 15 patented and 26 unpatented mines in the Tyndall Mining District in Santa Cruz County, Arizona in 1912. The company business location was Tucson, AZ. Directors of the company in 1912 were A. G. Lewis, C. J. Price, L. D. Koch, B. H. Tallmadge, C. A. Moore and W. C. Carswell. It is interesting to note that the directors and their meetings were located in Topeka Kansas and many of the stockholders and their meetings were located in Tucson, AZ.
