Leonard Marcisz currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Arizona Historical Society, a State of Arizona trustee agency that oversees several museums and historic properties across the state. Marcisz previously served on the Society board from 2011 through 2015, including service as the board secretary in 2013- 2014, and as the board president during 2015. He was reappointed to the board by Governor Ducey in 2018.

Marcisz has also served as Vice Chairman of the City of Scottsdale's Historic Preservation Commission. He served on the Board of Directors of the McDowell Sonoran Conservancy from 2005 through 2011, and is a former Chairman of the Board.

His articles regarding the history of the McDowell Mountains have appeared in several local periodicals. His research and monographs have been quoted or footnoted in various archaeological and historical publications. He has served as a consultant to several local museums and conservation organizations. He is an occasional scriptwriter and narrator for the Scottsdale City Cable TV Channel 11 historical series "Scottsdale Yesterdays."

He is also a Marine veteran.

He and his wife, Lindy, reside in Scottsdale and are the parents of three sons: Jacob, Joshua and Drew.
