Bruce Dinges recently retired after over thirty-one years as Editor of *The Journal of Arizona History* and Director of Publications at the Arizona Historical Society.

He began his career as an editorial assistant for *The Journal of Southern History* and the *Papers of Jefferson Davis* at Rice University, and then worked as Assistant, Associate, and Acting Editor of *Arizona and the West* at the University of Arizona. He served for two decades as Executive Director of the Arizona History Convention.

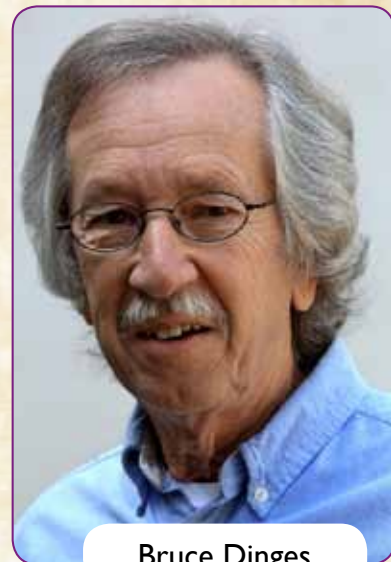
Dr. Dinges is former Sheriff of the Adobe and Tucson Corrals of The Westerners, and served as President of Westerners International. He is co-editor with Shirley A. Leckie of *A Just and Righteous Cause: The Civil War Memoirs of Benjamin H. Grierson* and author of numerous articles on Western and Arizona history.
