DAVID LEIGHTON: "STREET NAME ORIGINS IN TUCSON"

David Leighton, renowned "Street Smarts" columnist at the *Arizona Daily Star*, was born in Scotland and moved to Tucson when he was about nine years old. He grew up here and fell in love with the city's history. He is a graduate of Amphitheater High School and Pima Community College.

David is the author of *The History of the Hughes Missile Plant in Tucson, 1947-1960*. He has written the Street "Smarts" column, which he conceived, for about six and a half years.

He has been on PBS and the Travel Channel as well as numerous radio shows. He is currently under contract with *Arizona Highways Magazine* to do a story on the life of noted photographer Ray Manley.
