DESCRIPTION

This collection consists of two folders with receipts and legal papers referencing some prominent Arizona businesses. The first folder contains an insurance policy on the Electric Light and Power Co. written by Norwich Union Fire Insurance Society of Norwich and London England; share certificates; and letters directing legal requests. The second folder contains receipts from different businesses of Tucson, and Tombstone, Arizona many associated with L. M. Jacobs & Co., General Merchandise of Tucson, Arizona. No documents in this collection refer to George H. Amos.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

George H. Amos was a long time Tucson resident and employee for Tucson Reality and Trust Co. He was born in Owosso, Michigan on October 3, 1894 and came to Tucson in 1910. While attending high school in 1911 he began working for Tucson Reality delivering papers. Mr. Amos attended the University of Arizona and served two years with the military in World War I. In 1933 Mr. Amos became president of Tucson Reality and Trust and chairman of the board in 1967. He married Edna Shaw in 1927. After suffering a heart attack he died January 20, 1976.
