Dr. Morris D. Cohen received his medical degree from the University of Maryland in 1904 and began a medical practice in Bisbee, Arizona in 1905. In World War I, he served overseas in the United States Army Medical Corps and attained the grade of major. In 1920, he opened a medical practice in Tucson. He died in Tucson in 1967.
