At this time, all Arizona Historical Society (AHS) museums remain open to the public, although all public programming and events are canceled through March 31. In this uncertain environment, we understand that you may have concerns about visiting our museums at this time. If you choose to visit, know that the safety and well-being of our guests, staff and volunteers remain our top priority. Actions taken include:

- Limiting tours to 8 people or fewer at one time
- Increased cleaning protocols throughout the museums
- Hand sanitizer dispensers added for guest and staff use
- Removal of certain interactive objects and/or closure of some interactive exhibits
