Call For Artists

Project – Adirondack Chair Auction

Design is to represent an artist's interpretation of a special place or theme from the Yuma County area, either historical or current time, painted on an Adirondack Chair. Chairs will be auctioned online to fundraise for the Molina Block Agriculture Open Air Museum. Chairs will go to the highest bidder that may want to display the chair in their place of business-such as a store front window, a home patio or any special place to enjoy both the beautiful piece of art, as well as comfort for sitting.

PHASE I: Call to artists - November 1 – 15, 2022.

Flyers and the utilization of social media to distribute information to potential artists or location where artists may have access to flyer to learn about project.

PHASE II: Applicants to submit sketches of a proposed design to be painted on an Adirondack Chair. Sketches due to Yanna Kruse by December 1, 2022. Committee will review and select six (6) artists to participate in the project. Chairs to be distributed to artists December 15, 2022.

PHASE III: Chairs to be returned to the Yuma County Historical Society by February 15, 2023, with artwork completed.

PHASE IV: Sanguinetti Gardens will feature display of chairs to the community Spring, 2023. Various types of presentation through social media and print will advertise auction. Auction will take place online. Winners will be notified by phone and/or email.
