 - David N and Sebastian are reviewing FY24 and FY25 revenue performance to better inform the drafted FY27 budget, relying on historic actuals than expected returns.

 - 2) Expenditures: \$3,112,966.39 (planned \$4,557,129)
- 5. Legislative & Federal Update David Breeckner
 - a. SB-1017 (Pioneer)
 - Bill passed Senate Appropriations with unanimous, bipartisan support on 2/25/25.
 - At this time, AHS does not expect the bill to advance.
 - AHS maintains hope that this proposal may survive into budget negotiations

but without a bill to earmark it.

b. HB-2339 (AHS Chapters)

- Bill passed House following amendments by AHS; transmitted to Senate on 2/27/25.
- At this time, AHS does not expect the bill to advance.
- This bill would create Chapter-driven financial funds to support building maintenance and development.

c. ILMS, NEH, & Federal monies

- The Federal elimination of the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) and recent grant cancellations by the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) will result in an estimated **\$7.75m** loss in direct funding to Arizona museums and libraries. Arizona Humanities has cancelled all of its 2025 grants, due to its loss of Federal funding.
 - To-date, this has resulted in approximately \$213,000 lost in cancelled grant applications to AHS.
 - AHS is exploring what opportunities are available for alternative funding.
