- a. Update of Al Merito nominations (nominations sent to committee members)

# 6. Legislative Updates- David Breeckner

- a. Inter-agency updates
  - Met on 4/21/25 with representatives & heads of State Parks, SHPO, Secretary

of State/Library & Archives, and Prescott Historical Society. Follow-up scheduled for 5/21/25.

- b. Legislative updates
  - No changes in AHS' previous bills; awaiting release of budget for news on Pioneer funding
  - Current discussion of potential recession & shortages in State budgets
- c. Federal updates
  - IMLS, NEA, NEH grant programs cut **\$8.2m** annual loss to Arizona
  - Proposed changes to Federal taxes would negatively impact NPO finances & States
    - Temporary increase to standard deduction
    - Increased taxation of "assets" held by Foundations
    - Removal of Federal Medicaid & SNAP support

#### 7. 2024 CHI Small Grants Report

- a. Update on incoming reports from last year's grantees.
  - Final grant reports are due on the 15th of the month. 7 reports of the 31 funded have been received. AHS Grants Coordinator will review the reports and will have details by June or July.
- 8. Announcements and considerations in future board or committee meetings.
  - a. AHC shutdown update
    - Due to unforeseen circumstances, the HVAC vendor did not receive the necessary part for the replacement/ repair. AHC will have to close down later this year to address the work. Tentatively, the parts will arrive in 6 to 12 weeks.
  - b. Jaynie Adams will be in Thatcher in August to sit on a panel that will discuss historical buildings as peacemakers and how our certified historical institutions use historical buildings to tell stories and participate in their local economies.
