BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: The collection belonged to a Mr. Howenstein, who is known to have served as a Lutheran chaplain to German prisoners of war in Coolidge, Arizona, ca. 1947.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: This collection consists of photographs of the Phoenix Indian School and various locations across Arizona. A large portion of the photographs in the collection detail the 1947 home of Lotta W. Broadbridge at 4040 N. Pontatoc Road in Catalina Foothills, Tucson, Arizona. Also included in the collection are two black and white landscapes of the Painted Desert and portraits of unnamed individuals at various locations across Arizona, including Phoenix, Tucson, Glendale, and Coolidge. Photographs of the Phoenix Indian School show preparation for the 1959 graduation, as well as portraits of the students and staff.
