Historical Sketch

Helen Hamlin Allen, 1884-1963, was a native of Phoenix and barber for thirty-five years in the old Commercial Hotel (Luhrs Hotel). Her father, George Hamlin, who came to Phoenix in 1860, had a livery stable and served as superintendent of the Relief Mining Company. Her collection includes photos of the Salt River Valley, mining, scrapbooks, photographs and post cards, tax statements, canceled checks, correspondence/papers of the Relief Gold Mining Company.
