#### MS 0802 GENERAL STORE, TUCSON (ARIZ.) LEDGER, 1862-1868

### DESCRIPTION

1 ledger kept by an unnamed general store, probably Solomon Warner's store as later entries relate to transactions between customers and Solomon Warner; the business operated in Tucson, the ledger is for the years 1862-1868. Has records of purchases made by private individuals as well as businesses, e.g. the Tucson Billiard and Saloon. A great deal of the accounts are for liquor so the ledger was previously labeled as the "Tucson Saloon and General Store," but it does not seem to be for an individual saloon. Many prominent Tucson citizens had accounts at this business, so its value is to see what could be purchased in Tucson in the 1860s. 1 box, .10 linear feet
