DESCRIPTION

Small collection of miscellaneous papers of the Antonio Urdangarin family around Tucson. The papers include property deeds for property around Tucson as well as mining deeds for gold quartz mines in the Sierrita Mining District (Pima County). The collection also includes personal correspondence written by Antonio Urdangarin to his wife and son in Tucson in 1863 and 1868 as well as some other family correspondence (in Spanish). Also includes certificates for baptism and confirmation. Family photographs include two tintypes of family members though they are not clearly identified.

The Urdangarin family appear to have been in Tucson as early as 1863 and stayed through the 1920s. No other biographical information on the family is available.
