DESCRIPTION

The bulk of the collection is one typewritten manuscript entitled *Reminiscences from the Life of John Rope: "Old Timer" of the White Mountain Apaches* as told to Grenville Goodwin. The manuscript (1935) describes John Rope who was born around 1855. The manuscript primarily covers his experiences as a scout for the U. S. Government and his boyhood with the White Mountain Apaches in the San Carlos area. He describes scouting with Al Sieber and various scouting expeditions including the Apache Kid. Includes one folder of correspondence between Goodwin and Edith Kitt of the Arizona Pioneers Historical Society.
