The first folder includes stock certificates and articles of incorporation registration from Hotel Grimshaw. The third folder contains stock certificates for the Cia Mineria y Reduccion del Golfo in Mexico. The fourth folder has a partial release of mortgage. The fifth folder contains personal notes from various banks and canceled checks. The sixth folder has newspaper clippings, and the final folder has correspondence relating to Grimshaw's employment with various railroads.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

H. L. Grimshaw was born in Brooklyn, New York on July 2, 1859. He married in 1887 and had one son, Hal. He lived in Colorado for 20 years as a railway conductor before moving to Goldfield, Nevada in 1904. There he opened Hotel Grimshaw, which he thriving at the time of his death on July 2, 1909. He died in Phoenix due to heat exposure.
