DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists of photocopies of the memoirs of Rachel Mix Herrera, including her childhood in Nogales, Arizona and homesteading east of Nogales in the early 1900s. She writes a biography of her husband, Royal "Roy" Robert Herrera and his childhood in Tombstone, Arizona. She also mentions San Rafael Ranch, visits to Sonora, Mexico and early political developments and personalities in Arizona. Folder one contains her 65 pp. of memoirs, and folder two holds correspondence with the Arizona Historical Society with some elaboration on her history.
