DESCRIPTION

Small collection of assorted materials relating to the life of Henry Jaastad. Collection includes the memorial book from his funeral in 1965, two photographs including one with Eleanor Roosevelt, a manuscript entitled "A Short Summary of Expenses Imposed on the City of Tucson by the State Legislature Without the Consent of the City, also Some Notes on the Beginning of the End of Democracy in Our State, from a Layman's Viewpoint" by Henry O. Jaastad, Mayor. Also includes biographical newspaper clippings.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Henry O. Jaastad, architect and mayor of Tucson was born in Norway and came to Tucson in 1903. He served on Tucson's City Council for four years before being elected mayor in 1933. He served as mayor for fourteen years. He designed more than forty churches, more than fifty schools, other public buildings and more than 400 private homes. He died in Tucson in 1965.
