Papers include a diary (1936-37) as well as other autobiographical materials for Kelly. Also includes some mining claim papers and a map for the Armistice Mine in Cochise County. His reminiscences were written to claim "old age benefits" but describe his work in Cochise County. Also includes some poems written by Kelly and others.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Lon Kelly, miner, came to Tombstone in 1880. He mined in the Huachuca mountains and worked at the Sierra Bonita Ranch as well as for mining and logging companies in Cochise County and in Sonora, Mexico.
