**DESCRIPTION**

A small collection mostly consists of research, correspondence, and writings about travel on the Colorado River. Included are the narratives "Colorado Adventure" by Charles Mann, no date, and "In an Open Sailboat" by George Clark, dated 1893. The correspondence, mostly with the Arizona Historical Society, includes transcribed newspaper articles about mining, the Grand Canyon, and the Colorado River. Also included is a copy of the log "Ships Journal - Cruise of the Examiner in the Gulf of California, from Yuma, Arizona to Guaymas, Mexico" by George Flanell, 1894, and a typescript of a log by Barry Goldwater about a 1970 trip on the Colorado River, and an unidentified log dated 1960.
