Diploma donated by Robert Hitchings of the Norfolk Public Library, Virginia, in September 2002. Potter School photographs and miscellaneous materials donated separately by Ann McQueen (daughter of Sally Hanson) and Colette Altaffer in 2021. Some "Post Script" yearbooks were removed and cataloged individually.
