PC 273 Unidentified Tucson family collection 1940 - 1943

DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists of 64 small photographs from a family photo collection taken in the early 1940s. Images depict homes, mountain landscapes, and family members. No family names are present on the photos but other captions identify many of the scenes and locations. A reference to the family's home is made to Speedway Blvd. and Harrison. Of special interest to the family were images showing Arizona mountain landscapes and cactus. Some photos reference 9th street, Campbell Ave., Oklahoma Ave., Staggs Ranch, Broadway Blvd., and the Tucson Rodeo Parade. Several photographs are labeled 1940 through 1943.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

This collection has unidentified family members who lived in Tucson in the early 1940s. Although no last names are recorded on the photographs, several references identify the young boy as David and his sister Marion. There is also an image of their mother but no first or last name is present. Another image states that David had gained 13 pounds and may indicate that the family came to Tucson for health reasons.
