HISTORICAL NOTE: The Southern Arizona School for Boys (SAS), a college preparatory ranch school, was founded by Russell Fairgrieve and George Harper. Their goal was to supplement academic studies with a variety of outdoor activities. They broke ground on an 80 acre parcel near Sabino Canyon in 1930. The lodges and main building were constructed with adobe bricks made onsite. Charles R. Minegar (1924-2013) taught at the Southern Arizona School for Boys (SAS) from 1953 to 1957. He left to study in Europe on a Fulbright Scholarship but eventually returned to SAS as Dean in 1966. The Southern Arizona School for Boys closed in 1973 and the property was sold to the Fenster School, formerly the Fenster Ranch School. In 1974 Fenster relocated its headquarters to the SAS site and incorporated students from S.A.S. and the nearby Valley School for Girls.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: This collection includes yearbooks, faculty lists, a general information publication for S.A.S. for incoming students in 1953, as well as ephemera and many photographs. The photographs are primarily snap shots but also include large format commercially taken photographs, generally from Manley Commercial Photography.
