HISTORICAL NOTE: The Daughters of the American Revolution is a national society with membership open to any woman who is eighteen years of age or older and who is descended from a man or woman who served as a soldier, sailor or civil officer at the time of the American Revolution. The National Society was founded October 11, 1890. Its purpose is to perpetuate the memory and spirit of the men and women who achieved American Independence through protection of historical locations, erection of monuments, encouragement of historical research, preservation of documents and records, and promotion of celebrations of patriotic anniversaries. The Tucson Chapter was organized on February 27, 1915.
