BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Lura Leona Babbitt Fuller (1889-1978[?]) was born in Ohio and moved to Tucson around 1946. She and her husband, Francis Lee Fuller, were active for many years in the Tucson Camera Club.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: This collection consists of journals written by Lura Fuller from 1963-1978. A second journal in 1968 covers a trip to Europe that ran from April to June. The journals provide brief summaries of her activities, including errands, travel, and social gatherings. Some entries refer to the Tucson Camera Club, of which she and her husband were longtime members. Pages are interspersed with clippings, event programs, and correspondence.
