BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: After graduating from Arizona State University, James W. Garrison began practicing with Janus Associates in Phoenix, Arizona. As a historic architect, he facilitated the rehabilitation and restoration of many historic structures throughout the state. His expertise in historic architecture led him to a 24-year term as the Arizona State Historic Preservation Officer, a position he assumed in 1992. Garrison's work in historic preservation and implementation of the Arizona Historic Preservation Conference earned him the distinction of having the James W. Garrison award named in his honor.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: The collection primarily consists of architectural drawings for residential additions and alterations, churches, and commercial projects across Arizona from the 1970s to late 1980s.
