BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Harriet Kerlin Ade was born on April 27, 1892 in Dubuque, Iowa to Charles and Elizabeth Ade. On June 26, 1918, she married Nick C. Hall. The couple moved to Tucson in the early 1930s, where Nick and several business partners purchased the Santa Rita Hotel, of which Nick became the manager. Nick played a pivotal role in bringing filmmakers to Tucson, including the building of Old Tucson for the film "Arizona." Harriet was actively involved in the Tucson social and arts scene. She passed away in 1961.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: This collection contains two scrapbooks that include correspondence, newspaper articles, photographs, and a written family history. Loose materials from the scrapbooks are in folders inside the scrapbooks. Scrapbook #2 also contains several photographs that accompanied the donation. Photographs of the Tonkin family that accompanied this donation were added to PC 1000 Portraits.
