#### **Award Information**

**Awards are a reimbursement. Fellows will be reimbursed after the required public engagement is completed and the narrative report is received.** Fellows must sign up in the State of Arizona Procurement Portal. A Social Security Number or Tax ID Number are required. AHS research fellows are responsible for booking their own flights or other travel arrangements and lodging, as well as finding options for meals. Awardees are required to 1) engage the public with their research through either joint social media posts with AHS, interviews with AHS staff, or through virtual public programs, etc. and 2) to submit a 2-3 page narrative report recounting their research funded by AHS and the impact of that research on their project.
